DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Read and understand the Safety Data Sheet before using this product. SDS can be acquired by visiting www.bostik.com.au or by scanning the relevant QR code on pack.

SURFACE PREPARATION

1. Ensure surfaces to be bonded are clean, dry and free from grease, oil dust and other foreign materials.
2. Cut tip off the nozzle at 45° angle. DO NOT CUT too close to the ridge on the nozzle as this clips on the cap back on the bottle.
3. Test on small area before use.

APPLICATION

1. Apply Bostik Hobby Craft PVA glue to one surface and press both surfaces together whilst wet.
2. For wood, apply pressure or clamp for 20-30 minutes, longer for joints under stress.
3. Maximum strength is reached after 12 hours.
4. Clean away excess glue with a moist cloth.
5. Clean nozzle and/or replace cap tightly.

CLEANING/REMOVAL

9. To remove from substrates clean away glue with a moist cloth before maximum strength is reached for 12 hours.
10. To remove dried PVA use a cloth soaked with Eucalyptus oil.
11. Test for colourfastness. Then soak in hot water and scrub with a fine brush such as a toothbrush.

STORAGE AND SHELF LIFE

Store in a cool dry place between 5 to 25° C and out of direct sunlight. Shelf life is 12 months from the date of manufacture when stored as directed.
