APPLICATION

PREPARATION

Application temperature +5°C to +40°C (applies to environment and substrates). All substrates must be solid, clean and free of grease and dust. Clean substrates with Cleaner.

Bostik MAMUT Glue adheres perfectly without the use of a primer to most non porous substrates. Porous substrates to be pre-treated with Primer Universal. Always test adhesion prior to application.

APPLICATION

- Bostik MAMUT Glue was specifically developed as a universal adhesive for bonding many lightweight porous and non-porous building materials.
- For bonding HPL and cement fibre panels, please contact local Bostik technical team for advice.
- Apply adhesive in vertical stripes with 10-20cm distance between stripes. Bring the materials into position and press firmly so that the adhesive is a minimum of 2-3 mm thick between material and surface. Do not apply the adhesive in dots! Support and or clamping during curing may be necessary. For further questions, please contact our local technical team.

CLEANING

- Uncured material and tools can be cleaned by using Cleaner.
- Cured material can only be mechanically removed. Hands can be cleaned with Wipes.

STORAGE

- Store between +5°C and +25°C and in shaded conditions.
- Shelf life is 12 months when stored as recommended in original unopened packaging.
