SURFACE PREPARATION

1. Ensure that surfaces to be bonded are clean, dry, and free from grease, oil, dust, and other foreign materials.

APPLICATION

2. Remove protective cap. Turn base clockwise until glue protrudes (only expose a little glue for use). For best results apply twice before sticking substrates together.

3. When finished, turn base anti-clockwise to retract glue. Recap when not in use.

STORAGE

Store in a cool dry place between 5 to 25° C and out of direct sunlight. Shelf life is 24 months from the date of manufacture when stored as directed.

PRECAUTION IN USE

Not suitable for damp, delicate, absorbent or newly decorated surfaces. If in doubt, test a small area first. The adhesive gets stronger with time, so take care when removing. Recommendations and suggestions are for guidance only since conditions of use are completely beyond our control. Not suitable for children under 36 months due to small parts - choking hazard. If contact occurs, wash area with water.
